WEBINARS:

This two-hour session attracted nearly 500 participants. The webinar served as an important platform for discussing how contractors can improve the efficiency and success of water infrastructure projects, offering insights from both Indian and international perspectives.

The session began with a **Welcome Address** by AWWAIndia Association Chairman, Mr. H. V. Patel, who warmly welcomed all participants and highlighted the significance of the event in fostering collaboration and knowledge sharing within the water sector. Mr. Patel emphasized the importance of creating strong partnerships between contractors, government bodies, and industry experts to enhance the execution and sustainability of water infrastructure projects.

Following the welcome address, the webinar moved into the Introductory Remarks by Ms. D. Thara, Additional Secretary (A&CV), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs. Ms. Thara introduced the topic and set the stage for a productive session, outlining the current challenges and opportunities in implementing water infrastructure projects from a contractor's perspective.

The Indian speakers included Dr. Ajay Kumar Singhal of L&T Ltd., along with Mr. Bhaskar Rao Gudluri and Mr. D. Hanumantha Chary from GVPR, who shared their valuable expertise. International perspectives were provided by Mr. Gino D'Agostini of Ric-Man Construction (USA), and Ms. Holly Nowak and Mr. Lee Spindler of Miron Construction Co. (USA).



The Forum was held on December 11th in Delhi and December 12th in Mumbai.

Patel, Chairman of AWWAIndia Association, delivered his presentation at the Delhi event, while Mr. Prasana Shah, Executive Committee Member of AWWAIndia Association, spoke at the Mumbai event, hosted at the Consulate General of the United States of America.
